For prescription costs to be eligible for sharing, applicants must have Medicare Part D as well. All sharing will be secondary to Medicare. There is only one PRA level available to these senior adults (see pricing calculator at <a href="http://ImpactHealth-Sharing.com">ImpactHealth-Sharing.com</a> ). This program is available only on an individual membership basis.
